Front-of-pack nutrition labelling schemes: an update of the evidence

This addendum of the JRC Science for Policy report “Front-of-pack nutrition labelling schemes: a comprehensive review” provides an update of the former publication regarding the effects of front-of-pack nutrition labelling (FOPNL) schemes on consumers’ understanding, food purchases, diet and health, as well as food reformulation. This addendum will further inform the Commission’s proposal for harmonised mandatory FOPNL announced in the Farm to Fork Strategy.

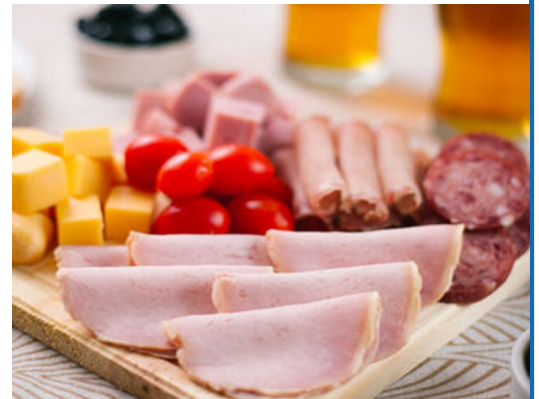
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Public consultation on nitrosamines in food: draft opinion explained

Nitrosamines (or more formally N-Nitrosamines) are chemical compounds that can form in food as a result of food preparation and processing. They have been found in several types of foodstuffs such as cured meat products, processed fish, cocoa, beer and other alcoholic beverages

EFSA’s draft opinion assesses the risks to public health related to the presence of nitrosamines in food.

Cost a concern for EU consumers, with food safety close behind

The cost of food is weighing more heavily on Europeans today than a few years ago, becoming the main factor influencing food purchases, followed by taste. Close to half consider food safety important too and 41% of EU citizens take for granted that the food they buy is safe.

These findings come from the 2022 Eurobarometer on food safety in the EU, the fourth such survey since 2005. Based on interviews with 27,000 people across the EU, it presents an evolving picture of how Europeans choose food, their food safety awareness and concerns, and who they trust for information on food safety issues.

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50th Session of Committee on World Food Security opens amid multiple challenges to global food security and nutrition

A key global policy platform addressing food security has opened its 50th session, with QU Dongyu, Director-General of the Food and Agriculture Organization of the United Nations (FAO) underlining its key supporting role amid the global food security crisis and its work on youth engagement and gender equality.
