FoodSafety4EU is a collaborative action to support the European Commission (EC) and its Agencies in shaping the **Food Safety System of the future**, by co-creating solutions for aligning research, policy and innovation with the societal needs and perspectives, thus improving food safety across Europe.

THE FS4EU APPROACH

The project is experimenting **new co-creation methodologies and tools** with institutions, EU Agencies, Food Safety Authorities, industry, SMEs, consumers and citizens associations by involving them in a structured and dynamic participatory process to **prioritize future research and innovation needs**.

THE FS4EU GOAL

The **23 project partners and 50+ supporting partners** will deliver a **multi-stakeholder platform**, including digital tools, to support the transition towards safe and sustainable food systems. The platform it's expected to become a Knowledge and competence Centre for Food Safety in Europe.

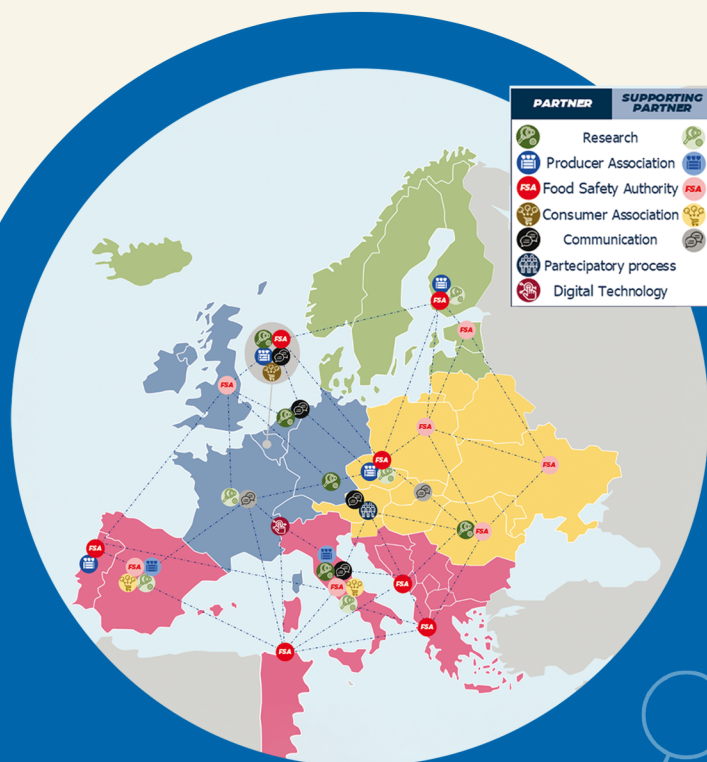
THE EU FOOD SAFETY PLATFORM
